

UPDATE ON MOVING FROM LEVEL 2 TO LEVEL 1

The following is an update to the Risk Assessment & Method Statement on moving from Level 2 to Level 1

The only significant difference is that we are now allowed to stay open indoors until 23.00 hours.

This will come into effect on Saturday 5th June.

Risk Assessment

The Club Committee continues to endeavour to manage and mitigate the risk for members using the facilities at Glenpark.

If the Method Statement is adhered to, the risks associated with Covid-19 will be mitigated as far as is reasonably practicable.

If you are shielding and/or residing with a close family member who requires to shield, please self-assess the risks applicable to you in entering Club premises.

Also anyone returning from traveling abroad from those countries identified by the Scottish government as identified as a risk will have to quarantine for the period laid down by them. Under no circumstances will any member or visitor in these circumstances be allowed within the club premises or grounds.

If you or anyone from your household, has symptoms, no matter how slight, you must not enter the premises of Greenock Cricket Club until you have quarantined for an appropriate period and are content that the risk of infection has been eliminated.

We have now been informed by the Scottish Government as from 5th June 2021 that the following rules will come into force:

Maximum of 8 people from 3 households outdoors. Children under 12 are not included in the total of 8.

Maximum of 12 people from 12 households outdoors. Children under 12 are not included in the total of 12.

When moving around ie going to and from the designated seating areas both inside and outside and toilets you must wear a face covering. All staff will also have to wear a face covering. There will be no exceptions to this rule, unfortunately anyone 'exempt' for whatever reasons, from wearing a face covering will not be allowed within the clubhouse.

If any of the safety measures we have put in place are breached, those doing so will be asked to leave the premises.

All persons within the precincts of Greenock Cricket Club will be deemed to have read and abide by the provisions of this Risk Assessment and Method Statement.

Method Statement

All signage and any one way systems must be adhered to in order to maintain the safety of any persons using the club and its employees.

There will be no access to the bar area, all persons within the designated inside seated areas must remain seated at all times and wait for a member of staff to serve them, no person is permitted to be at the bar at any time.

Unfortunately due to limited numbers inside only members will be allowed inside until further notice.

For those seated outside a queue will be formed within social distancing along the front of the clubhouse towards the dressing room door. They must remain here until served by a member of staff. There is only one queue.

All members and guests **must** sign in legibly, leaving their name **'not initials'** and a contact telephone number. Guests **must also** be signed in and their full name, postal address & contact telephone number recorded in the Visitors' Book. This is now required by the Scottish Government for track and trace purposes in the event that there is an instance of Covid-19 within the premises.

Patrons using outdoor areas will be served in plastic glasses which should be disposed of in the bins provided.

Only one person should use the ladies' toilet at any one time. Access is through the main entry door. Please use the sign on the doorframe to show it is occupied and reverse it on departure.

Patrons are requested to sanitise tables/chairs etc before and after they use them.

A similar arrangement is in place for the gents' toilet. Again access is through the main door.

Appropriate social distancing protocols should be maintained in all interior and outside areas, including the marquees.

Please do not congregate at doors.

While children are welcome within the club grounds, no children are to enter the Clubhouse except for the purpose of using the toilets.

We would also note that no alcohol can be brought into the club or the outside grounds areas. Anyone found doing so will be banned from the club indefinitely and may also be reported to the appropriate authorities for further action.

It should also be noted that guests can only be signed in a limited number of times, anyone exceeding these times will be asked to leave.

This Saturday is the first game for senior cricket and as such we must follow government guidance on social distancing for teams from outwith our area.

This means that on Saturday all club members and players from Glenpark will access the grounds from the double gates on Fox Street. Greenock players will wait at the tented area at the Fox Street gates for the entirety of the match, no other persons will be allowed in this area.

The opposition players will access the grounds from the Brisbane Street gate. This gate will be locked and only opened to allow members of the opposition to gain entry. They will then proceed to the tent erected at the pavillion, this will be their holding area for the entirety of the game. No members or players from Greenock will be allowed to access this area until after the game has benn completed.
